

# Am I Ready for the Rapture?

### 1. Salvation - Only through Faith in Jesus

The Bible is clear: salvation is a gift from God, received only through faith in Jesus Christ.

#### Ephesians 2:8-9:

'For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, so that no one may boast.'

Those who believe in Jesus with their heart are saved - that is the foundation.

### 2. Being Ready for the Rapture - Walking with Jesus

Salvation is the beginning, but the rapture is for those who are watchful, obedient, and fully committed to Jesus.

Matthew 25 (The Parable of the Ten Virgins) shows that some were waiting for the Bridegroom, but not ready - they missed the rapture.

#### Luke 21:36:

'Watch therefore, and pray always that you may be counted worthy to escape all these things that will come to pass, and to stand before the Son of Man.'

## 3. Is There Still a Chance After the Rapture?

Yes. After the rapture, the Great Tribulation begins (Revelation 6-18). Many will still come to faith in

Jesus.

Revelation 7:14 says:

'These are the ones who come out of the great tribulation, and washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.'

But it will be extremely difficult: no buying or selling without the mark (Revelation 13), persecution, and martyrdom.

Important: Whoever takes the mark of the beast can no longer be saved.

Revelation 14:9-10 clearly warns:

'If anyone worships the beast and his image, and receives his mark... he shall drink of the wrath of God.'

Come to faith in Jesus Christ now. Make Him the Lord of your life - now is the time of grace!

### 4. The Marriage Supper of the Lamb - The Reward of the Bride

Revelation 19:7-9 describes the wedding supper of the Lamb. Jesus is returning for His Bride - a holy, devoted Church.

Ephesians 5:27:

'...that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle, holy and without blemish.'

The rapture is not a reward for perfection, but for devotion. The Bride lives in expectation, surrender, and holiness.

## Summary

- Faith in Jesus saves you for eternity.
- Living in watchfulness and surrender prepares you for the rapture.
- After the rapture there is still grace, but under great hardship.
- Jesus is coming back for a pure and devoted Bride.
- Whoever takes the mark of the beast cannot be saved.
